Since October 2010, Wolfson College has been led by Professor Sir Richard Evans FBA. Sir Richard has made a remarkable impact on the College's academic life, and has supported the growth of Wolfson as a lively centre for modern culture.

The final year of the College's £5 million 50th Anniversary Campaign, which runs alongside Sir Richard's Presidency, provides the ideal opportunity to reflect on Wolfson's achievements over the past six years. When Sir Richard was appointed President in 2010, the College was able to allocate £34,000 a year for student scholarships and bursaries. Today, we can give almost £350,000 to support our students, thanks in no small part to the generosity of Wolfson's donors, and the College's endowment has doubled in size.



Since Sir Richard arrived at Wolfson, he has been knighted in the Queen's Birthday Honours 2012 for services to scholarship, has led a Leverhulme-funded research project on conspiracy and democracy, and has published three books: *Altered Pasts* (Little, Brown, 2014), *The Third Reich in History and Memory* (Little, Brown, 2015) and *The Pursuit of Power* (Penguin, 2016). Sir Richard's wife, Senior Member Dr Christine Corton, has also made a substantial contribution to College life, including chairing the Lunchtime Seminar Series, Humanities Society and Wolfson Reading Group, and has published a critically acclaimed book, *London Fog: The Biography* (Harvard University Press, 2015).
